Stoughton Utilities linemen recognized for response to Hurricane Sandy

Mayor Donna Olson, Utilities Director Robert Kardasz, and the Stoughton City Council recently commended the Stoughton Utilities linemen that traveled east to assist in storm restoration in the aftermath of Hurricane Sandy. John McLain, Brian Scheel, and Bryce Sime were given Outstanding Citizen Awards at the November 27, 2012 meeting of the City of Stoughton Common Council.
