## **Stoughton Utilities Now Accepting Scholarship Applications**

Stoughton Utilities encourages local high school seniors to submit an application for the Public Power Scholarship. The utility offers the annual scholarship in an effort to support young people from the community who plan to attend a technical school, college or university after graduation. Utility staff will award the \$1,000 scholarship to a Stoughton High School student in May of 2020.

To be eligible for the scholarship, students or their parents/guardians must be Stoughton Utilities customers. The scholarship recipient will be chosen based on the submitted application materials.

"At Stoughton Utilities, we make it a priority to support our neighbors in the community, especially young people who are just starting out. We thought a scholarship would be a good way to show them that we care and want them to succeed," said Utilities Director Jill Weiss.

The scholarship is made possible through community relations funding from the utility's not-for-profit wholesale power provider WPPI Energy.
